TO: All Steamship Agents, Owners, and Operators

SUBJECT: MODIFICATIONS TO PANAMA CANAL PRICING STRUCTURE

On April 27, 2010, the Panama Canal Authority (ACP) officially announced its plans to modify the Canal's pricing structure for all Canal segments: container, dry bulk, liquid bulk, vehicle carriers, refrigerated cargo, passenger, general cargo and others.

After a 30-day public consultation period, the ACP conducted a public hearing in Panama City, Panama on June 1, 2010, allowing interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposal.

Based on results of discussions with industry representatives, shipping lines, and government representatives, comments provided during the consultation period and public hearing, as well as the Canal's own internal analysis, the ACP has decided to postpone the implementation of the modified pricing structure until January 1, 2011, with the exception of refrigerated, cargo vessels, which will have an implementation date of April 1, 2011.

On June 15, 2010, the Cabinet Council of the Republic of Panama approved the modified pricing structure of the Panama Canal, following a recommendation from the ACP Board of Directors.
