TO : All Shipping Agents, Owners, and Operators

SUBJECT: Suspension of the Temporary Procedures for Small Craft Transits due to COVID-19 Pandemic

The Panamanian Government, through the Ministry of Health, has initiated the gradual reopening of certain restrictions that were implemented for several months due to the COVID-19 pandemic, such as quarantines and curfews.

As a result, the temporary procedures applicable to small craft under **20 meters** (**65 feet**) in length overall announced in Advisory A-14-2020 and implemented since April 9, 2020, are hereby suspended. The Panama Canal Authority (ACP) in conjunction with the Ministry of Health will continue to monitor the current situation regarding the COVID-19 pandemic and will announce any changes to these procedures in a timely manner.
